Tim Scott, Director of Exhibits – serves as the lead exhibit developer and fabricator for *Ocean Bound!* Tim joined the Sciencenter’s leadership team in 2010, with over 15 years of experience directing aquarium exhibit programs at Nauticus at The National Maritime Center, and as a Curator of Science Exhibits & Collections at the Virginia Aquarium & Marine Science Center. He oversees the work of the Sciencenter’s 8-person exhibits team, directs all exhibit development from conceptualization and design to final fabrication, gallery enhancements and the Sciencenter’s traveling exhibition program. Tim holds a B.S. in geology and an M.S. in Oceanography from Old Dominion University.

Lara Litchfield-Kimber, Deputy Director – serves as principal investigator of *Ocean Bound!*, the NOAA-funded \$750,000 grant project. Currently Deputy Director at the Sciencenter, Litchfield-Kimber is responsible for general museum management, special projects, and institutional advancement. Lara holds a MS in Plant Pathology from Cornell University and a BA in Biology from Amherst College. In 2010, she was named a Noyce Leadership Fellow. Lara is a member of the Tompkins County Public Library Board of Trustees.

David O. Brown, Cinematographer – serves as project partner with primary responsibility of filming and editing high-definition media for *Ocean Bound!* Brown works worldwide as a producer, videographer, photographer and lecturer. His work has aired on NBC, CBS, ABC, CNN, the Discovery Channel and National Geographic television. His award-winning photography appears in numerous exhibits and publications, including imagery for the Smithsonian's Ocean Planet and Ocean Hall and the American Museum of Natural History's Water display. As a member of the Cousteau team, Mr. Brown worked globally with vessels Calypso and Alcyone and lectured on behalf of the Cousteau Society worldwide. In addition to wildlife imaging, Mr. Brown has documented environmental events such as the 1989 oil spill in Prince William Sound, Alaska, and the discovery and raising of the submarine INS Dakar, subject of a National Geographic special that aired in 2002.
